## MONTHLY COMPETITION RULES

1. Competitions for images shall be held every 3 months. See programme for dates. There will be two prints and two projected images competitions.
2. A point system will operate for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and commended places in each assignment, the points accumulated over the year. The trophy will be presented annually to the winner with the most points.
3. Each member may submit up to 2 prints/images for each assignment. Prints must be mounted not larger than 20" by 16" (508mm by 406mm.) Each print must have the print title and photographer on the rear of the mount.
4. For Digital Images Competition you are advised to size and scale images to suit the club projector. See the Assignments section of the website.
5. The judges decision is final.
